

Chapter one : Nav station lights :

I don't recall what the lower left circuit breaker was originally, but I had removed that circuit. Then I wired the backlights for the circuit breaker panels to that lower-left breaker. Also, I wired the overhead nav light and a cigar lighter socket to it. When going into the dark boat, it is easy to locate by feel the lower left breaker, turn it on, and get some lights going. The cigar lighter outlet, I put on the top-front of the cabinet left of the nav station (above the seat). Yes, I got a cigar lighter- not a 12-volt power outlet. On the side of the cabinet I put one of those white plastic VHF holders. Be sure to put the holder low enough so the VHF antenna can fit in. I can also put my iPod or cell phone in the holder. I'd like to wire the steering pedestal light to that breaker so when I first get into the cockpit I can turn on the pedestal light. 2-10-2009 rep
